Award winners will be chosen on the following criteria:

- 1. This award is open to all high school seniors. Preference will be given to those entering a vocational, trade or technical field.
- 2. The student must have demonstrated a genuine sense of caring and willingness to help through volunteer efforts during their time in high school.
- 3. The student applying for this award must submit an essay that includes why he or she is attending their chosen course of study and why they should be selected for this award. Examples of volunteer efforts must be included in the essay as well.

The Jimmy Douglass Memorial Book Award selection committee will evaluate all applicants. If the committee requires clarification in determining a recipient, they will consult the high school staff. The selected recipient will be notified prior to or at graduation that they have been selected for this award.

Applications that are missing any of the required information will not be considered.

The award will be paid after the successful completion of the first semester; the recipient provides a copy of your first semester transcript, and proof that they are signed up for the next semester.
